### ORDER

Rajendra Prasad (P.G.) College, Meerganj, Bareilly-243504, Uttar Pradesh submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of National Council for Teacher Education for grant of recognition for BTC of Two Year duration in terms of section 15(1) of NCTE Act, 1993.

2. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to Rajendra Prasad (P.G.) College, Meerganj, Bareilly-243504, Uttar Pradesh for an annual intake of 50 seats (Fifty Only) (50 seats in the 1<sup>st</sup> year and the same for the II<sup>nd</sup> year in BTC course of two year duration with effect from 28<sup>th</sup> June 2005 subject to compliance of the following Conditions before the commencement of the academic session.

- Appointment of the faculty members duly qualified and staff as per the norms of NCTE/ State Govt./SCERT is to be completed before the commencement of the session.
- The countersigned statement of all faculty members from the Director, SCERT should be submitted before the commencement of the academic session.
- The institution shall adhere to all the other regulations and guidelines as framed by NCTE from time to time.
- The institution shall within one month of the receipt of Recognition order, convert the Endowment Fund account into a Joint Account in the form of FDR for a period of not less than 60 months (Five years) in a Nationalized Bank only to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.
- That the Reserve Fund for an amount equal to three months salary of the Teachers & Staff be created within one month from the date of issue of this order and maintained in the form of FDR in favour of the management/institution, for a period of not less than sixty months (Five years) in a Nationalized Bank.
- Before starting the course the institution should seek prior permission of the competent authority for conducting the exams and approval of the curriculum that they are going to adopt for the course.
- Institutions if starts the training programme without prior approval/permission of competent authority/examining body regarding the curriculum they have adopted and conduct of examination for award of Diploma/Certificate the recognition of such institutions shall be withdrawn.
- Non-compliance of the above mentioned conditions shall cause action under section 17 (1) of NCTE Act, 1993.

3. The Recognition is subject to the condition that the affiliating body shall ensure that, among other things, the institution has appointed required number of faculty members (including Principal / Head of Department), as per the norms of the NCTE / State Govt. / Affiliating body.

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4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like SCERT/ State Government, etc.
5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating body / State Directorate of Education about the appointment of faculty members and the Statement of Annual Accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and/or order made or issued there under, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

3. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition/permission to **Rejendra Prasad P.G. College, Meerganj Bareilly-243504, U.P.** for conducting B.P.Ed. Course of Secondary-PE (level) of one year duration with an annual intake of **50 (FIFTY)** students from the academic session **2008-2009** under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulation, 2007 notified on 10-12-2007 subject to fulfillment of the following:

- (i) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund accounts into joint accounts to be operated along with an officer of the Northern Regional Committee.
- (ii) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- (iii) The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE Regulations, 2007 notified on 10-12-2007.

4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed under relevant norms and standards of NCTE for other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc, wherever applicable.

LETTER OF INTENT PRIOR TO RECOGNITION

**Sub: Informing decision for grant of recognition or permission under Clause 7(11) of the NCTE Regulations, 2005 published on 13<sup>th</sup> Jan 2006 course.**

In terms of Section 15 of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Rajendra Prasad P.G.College, Meerganj, Bareilly, U.P. had submitted an application (Code No. UP-2481) to the NRC of NCTE for grant recognition for **B.P.Ed. Course** of 1 year duration with an annual intake of **50 students** at Rajendra Prasad P.G. College, Meerganj, Bareilly, U.P.

2. On the basis of the scrutiny of the documents submitted by the institution, input received from the Visiting Team Report and videography, the NRC in its 125<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 21-22 January 2008, is satisfied that the above institution has adequate financial resources, accommodation, library, laboratory as prescribed in the norms and standards and that it fulfils all such other conditions relating to infrastructural and instructional facilities required for proper functioning of the institution for a course in teacher education for **an annual intake of 50 students**.

3. However, as required under Para 7(11) of the NCTE Regulations, published on 13<sup>th</sup> Jan 06, it is requested that appointment of qualified faculty members before the commencement of the academic session be made and a compliance report be sent so that formal unconditional order under section 15(3)(a) of the NCTE Act and Clause 7(12) of the said Regulation be issued.

4. Now, the institution shall undertake appointment of faculty/staff by a duly constituted selection committee and ensure selection of candidates possessing qualifications as prescribed under rules. (A duly constituted Selection Committee means "Selection Committee constituted as per the policy of the Central/State Government/Affiliating Body concerned whichever is applicable") along with an Affidavit on the prescribed format (format enclosed) on Rs. 100 stamp paper from the Management of the institution and Affidavit on Rs. 10 stamp paper from the staff appointed and staff list.

5. Attention of the institution concerned is also drawn to section 7(12) of NCTE Regulations dated 13<sup>th</sup> Jan 2006, which reads as "The Institution concerned, after appointing the requisite faculty/staff, shall put the information on its official website and also formally inform the Regional Committee concerned. The Regional Committee concerned shall then issue a formal Unconditional Recognition Order". Hence, the Institutions shall host the details in the institution website and thereafter submit the details to NRC, NCTE.

6. The University is requested to submit the required information along with documentary proof duly certified by the concern authority to Northern Regional Committee, NCTE for its approval,

**ORDER**

**WHEREAS**, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993 (73 of 1993) and in supersession of the National Council for Teacher Education (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2009, the National Council for Teacher Education has notified the Regulations, 2014 on 01.12.2014.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, the recognition was granted by NRC to the said institution for B.P.Ed. Course vide order No. NRC/NCTE/F-7/UP-2481/2008/56134-56140 dated 12.08.2008 with an annual intake of 50 seats from the academic session 2008-2009.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution **Rejendra Prasad P.G. College, Meeranaj, Bareilly-243504, Uttar Pradesh** has by affidavit consented to come under New Regulations and sought for one basic units in B.P.Ed., which require additional facilities.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, it has been decided to permit the institution to have one basic unit of 50 students each subject to the institution fulfilling following conditions namely.

- (i) The institution shall create additional facilities that include (a) additional built-up-area, (b) additional infrastructure, (c) additional funds, (d) adhere to staff norms as per Regulations, 2014 and inform Regional Committees with required documents by October 31, 2015.
- (ii) The application-institution for additional unit will be required to submit the required documents such as land documents, Encumbrance Certificate (EC), Land Use Certificate (LUC) and the Building Plan (BP) in the specified proforma available on the website to the Regional Committee in proof of having provided additional facilities before October 31, 2015. Building completion Certificate (BCC) may be given along with other documents if available, otherwise it can also be given to the Visiting Team at the time of inspection.
- (iii) The Regional Committees shall arrange for verification of documents, inspection of these premises and check adherence to these condition by 20 February, 2016. If it is found by the Regional Committee that the institution fails to comply with these requirements, the institutions shall not be permitted to admit students for the academic year 2016-2017
- (iv) In case any existing institution's matter is sub-judice under court direction/SCN under section 17 of the NCTE Act/ Complaint etc., the institution shall be required to submit a copy of the Hon'ble Court order/reply to SCN/complaint/already submitted alongwith the documents, if any together the documents referred above. In case the institution's request for shifting of premises is pending, such institution shall be required to submit the requisite documents as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 with a copy of the order/NOC of the affiliating body/State Govt. and such other documents as indicated in the revised format recognition order. The final decision shall be subject to the directions given by the Hon'ble Court in the Writ Petition case decided by the Northern Regional Committee in respect of Section 17/complaint cases etc.

4. **Now therefore**, in the light of the above, the Northern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby issues the revised Recognition Order to **Rejendra Prasad P.G. College, Meeranaj, Bareilly-243504, Uttar Pradesh** for conducting B.P.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 for one basic units of 50 students from the academic session 2015-2016 subject to fulfillment of the conditions mentioned herein before 31.10.2015.

5. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, State Government etc. as applicable. The affiliating body (University/State Govt.) shall also be required to verify the authenticity of the land & building documents as well as appointment of requisite teaching & non-teaching staff as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 by the concerned institution before grant of affiliation to an institution.

6. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

7. The institution shall maintain & update its website as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure.

- (a) Sanctioned programmes along with annual intake in the institution.
- (b) Name of the faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- (c) Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last quarter.
- (d) Names of students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.
- (e) Fee charged from students.
- (f) Available infrastructural facilities.
- (g) Facilities added during the last quarter.
- (h) Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter.
- (i) The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- (j) The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
- (k) Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

If the institution Contravenes any the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made and issued there under, the institution will render itself liable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Regional Committee under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
